Twain Harte Weather in November

November, the last month of the autumn in Twain Harte, is also a moderate month, with temperature in the range of an average low of 40.1°F and an average high of 58.6°F

Temperature

The average high-temperature drops in November, from October's agreeable 70°F to a moderate 58.6°F The low -temperature in Twain Harte averages to a cold 40.1°F during the nights of November.

Humidity

In November, the average relative humidity is 54%.

Rainfall

In Twain Harte, during November, the rain falls for 6.5 days and regularly aggregates up to 3.07" of precipitation. Throughout the year, there are 77.4 rainfall days, and 29.06" of precipitation is accumulated.

Snowfall

January through May, November and December are months with snowfall. November is the first month it typically snows in Twain Harte. Throughout November, in the average 1.5 snowfall days, it receives 4.69" of snow. In Twain Harte, during the entire year, snow falls for 16.2 days and aggregates up to 38.07" of snow.

Daylight

The average length of the day in November in Twain Harte is 10h and 7min.

On the first day of the month, sunrise is at 7:27 am and sunset at 6:01 pm PDT. On the last day of November, sunrise is at 6:57 am and sunset at 4:41 pm PST.

Note: On Sunday, November 3. 2024, at 2:00 am, Daylight Saving Time ends, and the time zone changes from PDT to PST. Daylight Saving Time starts again on Sunday, March 9. 2025, at 2:00 am.

Sunshine

In Twain Harte, the average sunshine in November is 6.8h.


